

SWLS POLICY FOR USE OF ACCUCUT MACHINE AND DIES

This service started in 2001 with the help of 12 SWLS member libraries who supplied money to purchase the first dies from Accucut. Those libraries were: Blanchardville, Boscobel, Cobb, Cuba City, Dodgeville, Lancaster, Livingston, Lone Rock, Mineral Point, Montfort, Muscoda, and Viola. SWLS has periodically added to the collection of dies.

SWLS does not send the cutting machine and dies out to individual libraries due to the size and weight of the machine and lack of space on the van.

Libraries must supply their own material to cut-out the shapes.

Call to arrange a time to use the Accucut machine at SWLS to do their own die cutting

Use the Accucut machine after a meeting

You can cut almost anything with the Accucut machine that you can cut with a scissors, but some materials are harder to cut and more time-consuming.

Suggested materials that can be used in cutting shapes are:
